Breaking barriers through cooperation

The RECulture project deepens international cooperation in the field of sport, also thanks to the physical meeting of partners, which will take place on July 7, 2022 in Prague under the lead of the NextGen team.

The main objective of RECulture is to enable the community to develop local sports programs in an effort to integrate migrants into local communities. Thanks to sport, cultural and ideological differences between youth can be blurred. The project will trigger structural and systematic changes in Europe in the field of local sports programs.

At the second project meeting, partners from the Czech Republic, Ireland, Cyprus, Portugal and Greece intend to focus on the outputs associated with the project, especially on Best Practices Research.

This output will be addressed both nationally and internationally. As part of Best Practices Research, examples from practice between partners should be collected and compared. The aim is to figure out what can be improved in the future in terms of the project and sport. In addition, upcoming trainings, project meetings that will ease cooperation of partners will be discussed.

Summary and what awaits us next?

At the TPM1 (Transnational Partner meeting), the project partners had the opportunity to see each other in person. The RECulture project kicked off a series of regular TPM meetings in Dublin, Ireland, on February 8, 2022. Participants discussed the project as such, its objectives, administrative issues and funding. Among other things, it was also discussed what role the individual partners will have in the project and what are their responsibilities. In general, the topic also covered the website and the newsletter and its dissemination. The agenda also included target groups in the RECulture project.

Now the Prague endowment fund NextGen will take on the role of organizer of the second project meeting of the consortium. This will take place in Prague's Smíchov in Štefánikova Street on the symbolic date of 7.7.2022.

The agenda of the meeting will be in the spirit of partial outputs that the partners have declared to meet since the February meeting. There will be an exchange of experience related to the implementation of the project and also a review of the conclusions of IO1 Best Practices research.

In the context of Best Practices Research. partner teams conduct a catalogue of best practices which are specific for their country. The aim of it is to better understand how different international communities use sports programs to integrate refugees to local communities. This project output is more than topical regarding the Russian-Ukrainian conflict and wave of migrants.

The partners will also discuss the terms and finalization of other outputs related to the RECulture project, especially the translation of some outputs into the local language. The agenda will also focus on the next period and the associated international training which should take place in Greece.

We are confident that cross-border cooperation and deeper integration will lead to an exchange of knowledge between partners that will enable us to create tools to include communities of migrants in sports-oriented programs for young people.
